DETAILS

Dates? In 2010 we are looking at having the first ever Unquenchable Ministries Internship. The Internship is scheduled to start on April 15 and will be ending on June 25. Kira will be traveling to the USA for ministry engagements from the end of June to Aug. You are invited to travel for these trips but that is not part of the internship fees and the cost will be yours. Unquenchable Ministries at this time has not decided the dates for the second internship but will soon update.

Where will I be staying? Interns will reside in Kampala Uganda Africa. Lodging will be provided in a safe a secure compound. Interns will be staying with in walking distance of Kira and Stuarts home. Your safety and your security is of the utmost importance to our leadership team and we will take all precautions to insure your safety and comfort. Your rooms will be furnished for you.

What about transportation? Only ministry transportation is provided. We will also be using local transportation such as taxi's and Bodas (Motorbikes)

Do I need a visa? Yes, A tourist visa is what is required for your stay in Uganda. Upon arriving at the Entebbe Airport you will pay customs \$50.00 USD. This visa is valid for three months. Extensions can be made if you decide to extend your stay.

Cost? \$4,000 USD. First payment due: March 15 - \$2,000(Dates are some what flexible) Last payment due in full on day of arrival April 15, \$2,000 USD *for any financial questions or concerns, please email interns@unquenchableministries.com

Each individual is responsible to pay for his or her flights to and from Uganda. You will be flying into Entebbe International Airport in Kampala Uganda. As well as you are responsible to make sure you have required vaccinations and malaria pills. Malaria pills are not mandatory but highly recommended.

Do I need a passport? Yes. Please arrange for your passport in a timely manner. At times it can take a month or more.

When is the application cut off date? March 10 2010

How will I know if I have been accepted? All of those accepted into the program will be notified within a timely manner of receiving the application package.

What this includes: all living, traveling and ministry expenses. Unquenchable Ministries team believes in having fun. At the end of the internship we will be celebrating your graduation by going on a 2-day safari. You will be required to take care of other personal expenses. A large portion of the tuition is used on the ministry trips: air travel, transportation and lodging. Unquenchable Ministries has been very careful to make this internship as cost effective as possible.

Additional Costs: Personal expenses, vaccinations, medical travel insurance, malaria prescriptions and any personal outings.
